ORDER

WHEREAS, it appearing to the Court that three vacancies exist on the New Mexico Commission on Access to Justice due to the expiration of the terms of Kenneth (Kip) Bobroff, Jeffrey J. Wechsler, and Teague González, and the Court being desirous of filling said vacancies, Chief Justice David K. Thomson, Justice Michael E. Vigil, Justice C. Shannon Bacon, Justice Julie J. Vargas, and Justice Briana H. Zamora concurring;

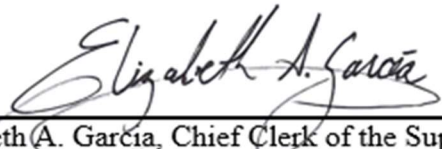
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Teague González is reappointed to the New Mexico Commission on Access to Justice for a three-year term, said term to expire December 31, 2027; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rebecca O'Gawa and Jennifer Salazar are appointed to the New Mexico Commission on Access to Justice for three-year terms, said terms to expire December 31, 2027.
